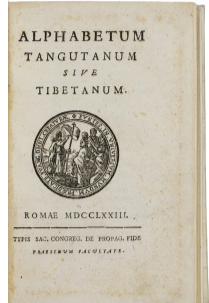

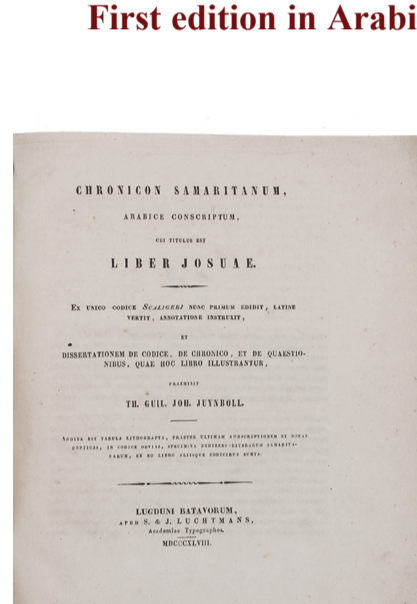

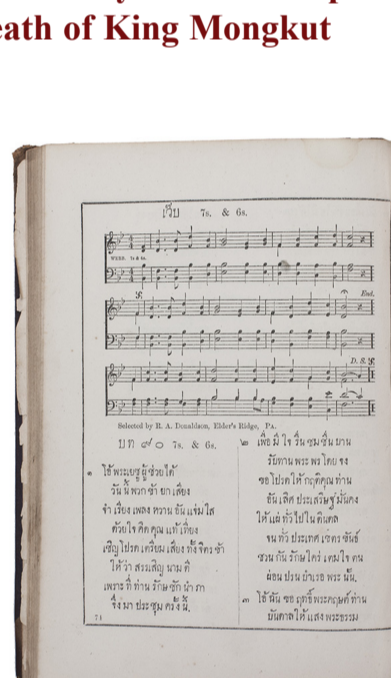

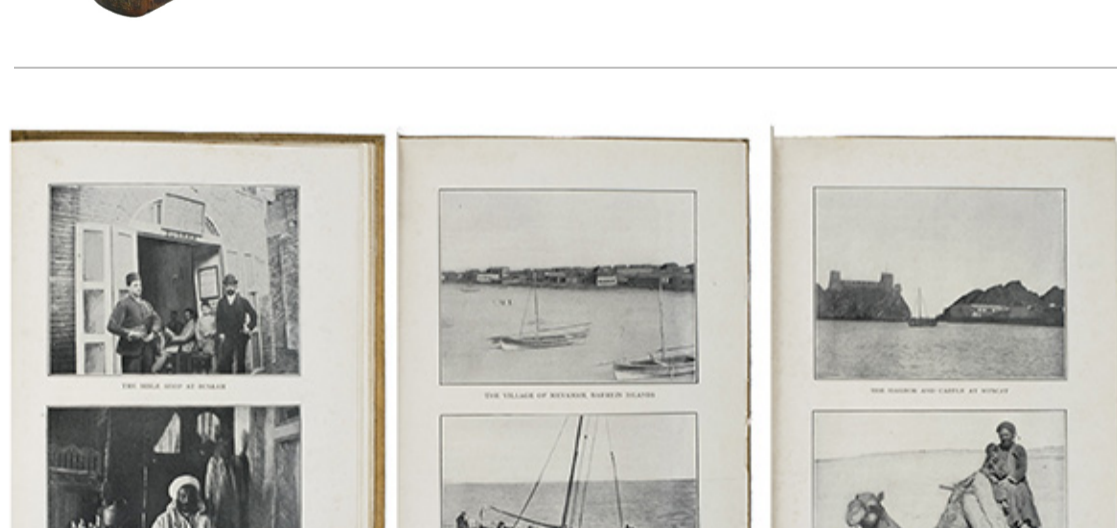

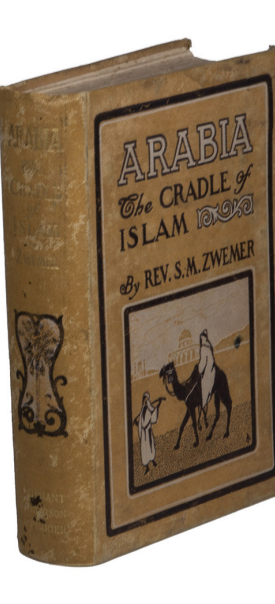

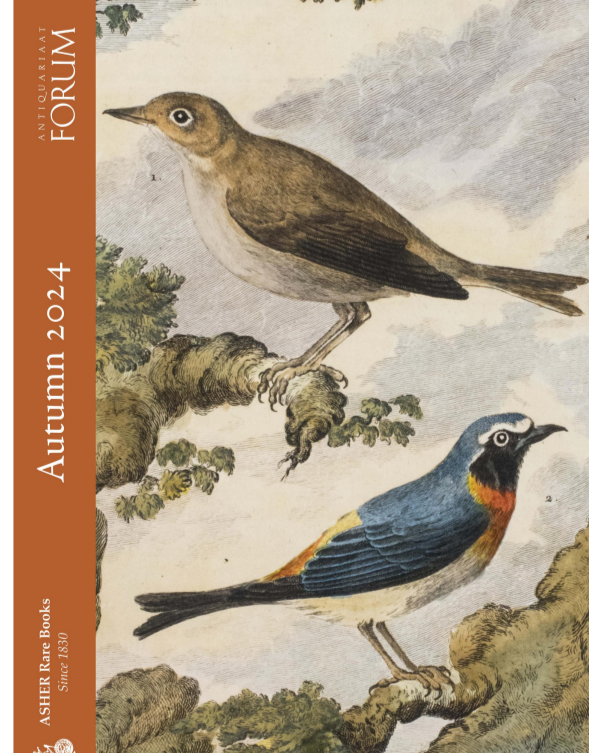


The Arabian Peninsula through the eyes of the American Christian missionary S.M. Zwemer

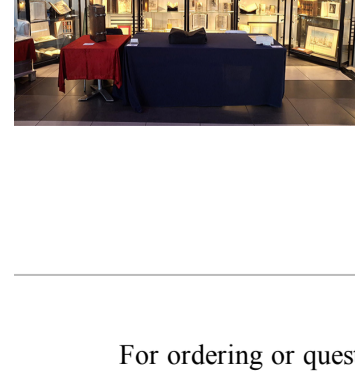
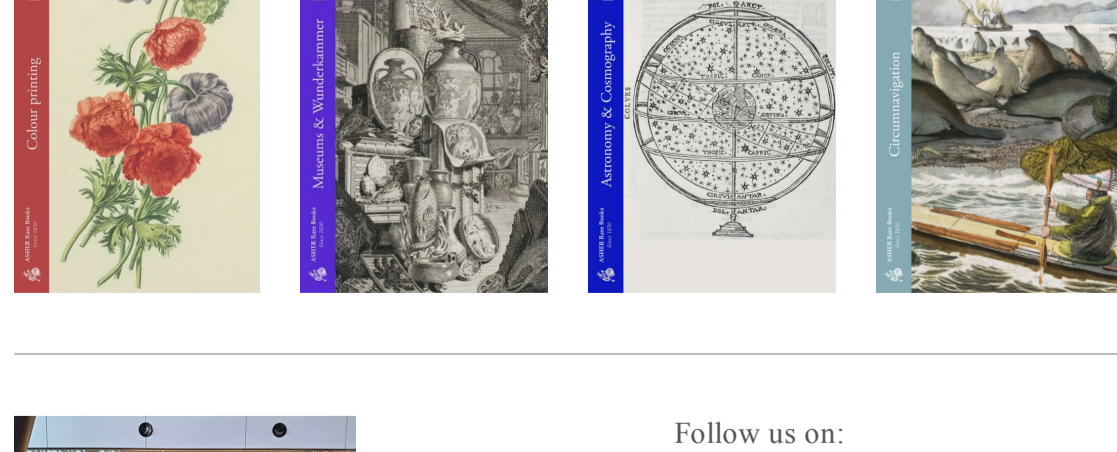

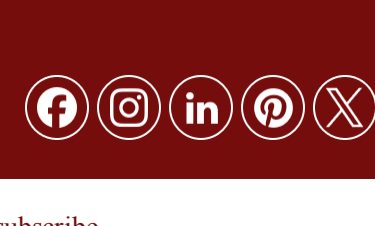
